2006 ANNUAL CONVENTION REGISTRATION

OFFICIAL CALL TO DISTRICT CONVENTION

Pursuant to Article VIII, Section 4 of the District Bylaws, the Kiwanis Clubs of the Kansas District are hereby notified the 56th Annual Convention of the Kansas District of Kiwanis International will be held August 11-13, 2006 at the Junction City CourtyardMarriott Hotel.

According to Article XVIII, Section 1 of the District Bylaws, proposed amendments to the District Bylaws, submitted by a club in good standing or the District Board of Trustees, shall be submitted to the District Secretary and received at least 60 days (June 14) prior to the convention date.

Resolutions shall be submitted according to Article IX, Section 2 of the District Bylaws. Resolutions shall be submitted to the District Secretary 30 days (July 13) prior to the date of the District Convention and shall be referred by the Secretary to the Committee on Resolutions for consideration and recommendation. No resolutions other than those submitted to or originated by the Committee on Resolutions shall be considered unless recommended by two-thirds vote of the District Board of Trustees.

HOUSE OF DELEGATES

Clubs in good standing are entitled to three delegates to the House of Delegates business meeting at the District Convention. Two of the delegates should be the president and president-elect. Each club may choose one alternate for each delegate, including the President and President-elect. Only delegates with an official delegate badge may present or speak on motions and vote. Delegate registration forms will be mailed out in mid-June and shall be returned ON OR BEFORE July 31, 2006, in order to have voting representation at the District Annual Business Meeting.

The House of Delegates meeting will be held at **3:00 p.m. Saturday, August 12, 2006 in the Cottonwood Ballroom.** The District business will be conducted and election of the 2006-07 District Governor, Governor-Elect, and District Treasurer shall take place during the business session.

INSTALLATION CEREMONY

The 2006-07 District Board of Trustees, District Committee Chairs, and the Kansas Kiwanis Foundation Board of Directors will be installed Sunday morning, August 13.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

The 2005-06 Board of Trustees will meet Friday, August 11, at noon to conduct business relating to the 2005-06 administrative year.

The 2006-07 Board of Trustees will meet after the Sunday luncheon August 13 to conduct business necessary to begin the 2006-07 administrative year.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Who should register - Spouses and guests are welcome to attend all general sessions and meals. **MUST REGISTER SEPARATELY TO GET AN INDIVIDUAL PACKET OF CONVENTION MATERIALS.**

2. Convention Status - Check boxes in STATUS section. This is very important for credentialing delegates and special registrations.

3. Convention & Event fees - Check applicable registration fee and which events you will attend on the registration form at the right. Every Kiwanian must pay the registration fee, even if only attending one or two events. Registrations postmarked on or before July 23rd will pay the EARLY BIRD discount rate of \$35.00. After this date, pay \$40.00 registration fee. This fee will also apply to walk-in registrations at the convention. Host club volunteers pay 1/2 registration fee.

4. Number of tickets - For each function you will attend, indicate the number of tickets needed and extend the total to the last column.

5. Total registration price - Add the ticket prices and registration fee for the total amount due. Send form and check for the total amount due to Kansas District Convention, P.O. Box 4463, Topeka, KS 66604-0463.

6. Hotel arrangements - Make your own hotel arrangements prior to July 12, 2006. The hotel will release block of special room rates that day. **Request the Kiwanis Convention rate** to pay \$79.00 plus tax, single or double occupancy. Call 785-210-1500 to make reservations or go to www.junctioncitycourtyard.com All reservations must be accompanied by first night deposit or guaranteed with a major credit card 24 hours prior to arrival. **After July 12, reservations may be made on a space available basis.**
